MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Tank Sprayer

- Add 4 fl oz (8 Tbs) to 1 gal of water

ORTHO® Dial 'n Spray®

- Set dial to 4 oz
- For each gal of spray add 4 fl oz to sprayer jar
- DO NOT add water
- After spraying, unused product can be poured back into its original container

1 Tablespoon (Tbs) = 3 teaspoons (tsp) 1 fl oz = 2 Tbs

How To Apply

- Use a coarse spray pattern to reduce drift to desirable plants.
- Spray weed to thoroughly wet foliage, stems and trunk.
- Do not spray plants or grasses you like - they may die too. Not recommended for weed control in lawns.
- If weed is growing around desirable plants, shield plants from drift with a sheet of cardboard or plastic, or cut weed at base & treat as directed for stumps.
- If desirable plant is accidentally sprayed, rinse off immediately with water.

For Stumps

- Apply product undiluted with a paint brush to the entire

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a safe place.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Securely wrap partially filled or empty container in newspaper and put in trash.

freshly cut stump, including the cut surface, remaining trunk & exposed roots.

- Do not reuse paint brush. Wrap brush in newspaper & put in trash.

For Vines

- If weed is growing up poles, fences or mature tree trunks, spray to thoroughly cover weed up to a height of 3 to 4 feet.
- If weed is climbing a shrub, to avoid damage to shrub, cut weed at base & treat as directed for stumps.

When To Apply

- Apply when weed is leafed out and actively growing.
- Apply when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants.
- Rain within 24 hours after application may reduce effectiveness.
- Wilting or yellowing will occur in 2 to 6 weeks. Hard to kill weeds may require a repeat application if regrowth occurs.

Note: Contact with Poison Oak or Poison Ivy anytime of the year can cause an allergic reaction. Handle dead plants with rubber gloves. Dispose of plants & rubber gloves in tightly sealed garbage bags.

Important

Do not use on or around edible feed or food crops.
