To Kill Stumps/For Stumps:

- If an ornamental shrub or tree is in the lawn, keep spray off foliage and exposed roots.
- Avoid mowing 1 to 2 days after application.
- If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application.
- Rain or watering 6 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness.
