DANGER

Causes irreversible eye damage and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May cause allergic skin reactions. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from area treated.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE

Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Store in a cool, dry place, but protect from temperatures below 0°F. Do not store or transport near food or feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner and container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS

DO NOT ADD SURFACTANT EXCEPT WHERE SPECIFICALLY INDICATED BELOW.

APPLES: Apple Scab (for protection to pink or petal fall stage to prevent primary infection stage only)—Spring Application in dormant or up to 1/4" Green Stage: Midwestern and Eastern States Only: For Protection to Pink Stage — Apply 15 lbs. in 100 to 400 gal's of spray per acre. Use the high gallonage for large trees. For Protection up to Petal Fall Stage — Use 6 1/2 lbs. (5 lbs. active) per 100 gal's of spray. Use sufficient spray (25 lbs. per 400 gal's spray per acre to large trees) to provide thorough coverage. May be combined with Superior type spray oil. Caution: Do not apply oils after DIFOLATAN applications as phytotoxicity may occur.

Applications of DIFOLATAN made after 1/4" green stage may cause fruit russet or phytotoxicity to primary leaves. For control of secondary apple scab and summer diseases use ORTHOCIDE (captan) or another fungicide registered for this use, beginning at the pink stage if the 15 lb. rate of DIFOLATAN was applied in the dormant period, or beginning when first petals fall if the 25 lb. rate of DIFOLATAN was applied in the dormant period. Do not prune trees following DIFOLATAN applications.

BLUEBERRIES: For Control of Fusiform Canker, Mummyberry and Phomopsis Twig Blight, Anthracnose Fruit Rot — Apply 2 1/2 to 5 lbs. (2 to 4 lbs. active) in 20 to 250 gal's spray mix per acre. Thorough coverage is essential. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.
