HOW TO USE: Shake before using. Hold back protective hinged tab exposing nozzle. Snip in place on sprayer top. Adjust spray nozzle to give a fine spray. Hold container about 12 inches from plant being sprayed. Spray until slightly wet.

KILLS: Aphids, Asparagus Beetles, Blister Beetles, Cabbage Loopers, Cross-striped Cabbageworm, Colorado Potato Beetle, Diamond-Back Moth Larvae, Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bug, Imported Cabbageworms, Leafhoppers, Leafhoppers, Mexican Bean Beetle, Webworms, Stink Bug, Twelve-spotted Cucumber Beetle, and Whiteflies.

PLANTS (VEGETABLES): Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Celery, Collards, Cucumber, Eggplant, Kale, Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach, Tomatoes and Turnips.

(FLOWERS): African Violets, Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Dogwood, Gladiolus, Marigolds and Roses.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: For storage, reseal by replacing tab closure over spray nozzle. To store, rotate nozzle to closed position. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT—Partially filled bottle may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. CONTAINER—Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
