**NET CONTENTS 1 GAL.**

**HOW TO USE:** Shake before using. Fold back protective hinged label on nozzle. Strip in place on sprayer top. Adjust spray nozzle to give a fine spray. Hold container about 12 inches from plants to be sprayed. Spray until slightly wet.

**KILLS:** Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Stink Bugs, Twelve Spotted Cutworm, Beetles and Whiteflies.

**PLANTS:** African Violet, Gladiolus, Azalea, Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Carnations, Chrysanthemum, Dahlias, Dogwood, Marigold and Roses.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** For storage, reseal by replacing tab closure over spray nozzle. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a shaded storage area. **IMPORTANT:** After each use, store upright with nozzle handle on container above liquid level of contents to prevent leakage and siphoning from nozzle.

**DISPOSAL PRODUCT—**Partially filled bottle may be disposed of by incineration, wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER—**Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
