

KILLS: Carpetweeds, Chickweeds, Creeping Charlie, Curly Dock, Dandelion, English Daisy, False Dandelion, Florida Pusley, Heart-leaf Drymary, Henbit, Oxalis, Pennywort, Plantains, Purslane, Red Sorrel, Sheep Sorrel, Spurges, Spurweed, Thistles, Toadflax, White Clover, Wild Carrot, Wild Geranium, Wild Onion.

How To Use: Adjust spray nozzle to give a coarse spray. Aim at center of weed and spray to wet. One application should be sufficient; however, a repeat application may be required in 2-3 weeks for hard to control weeds. Spray anytime weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 85°F. or if rain is expected to occur within 24 hours following application. Weeds in newly seeded lawns may be sprayed after lawn has been mowed 3 times.

To Prepare Refill: Add 2½ teaspoonfuls of WEED-B-GON Lawn Weed Killer, EPA Reg. No. 239-2342, to this empty container and then fill to the 20 oz. mark with tap water and use according to directions on this label.
