We have completed our review of the referenced label. The label, submitted on July 21, 1994, is acceptable provided that the following revisions are made at the next label printing:

In the "Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals" section;

- a. Re-insert the word, "socks", in the protective clothing statement.
- b. Add the statement, "Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower", to the hygiene statement.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating these revisions at your next label printing.

How To Use: Adjust spray nozzle to give a coarse spray or jet stream for spot treatments as needed. Aim at center of weed and spray to wet. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 85°F or if rain is expected to occur within 24 hours following application. Weeds in newly seeded lawns may be sprayed after lawn has been mowed 3 times.
