Spot Treatment - Fire Ants: To aid in the control of fire ants in lawns and other recreational areas, apply 1/2 cup over and 6 ft. around each fire ant mound. Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Do not use more than 2 gallons of water. Apply water gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering may disturb the ants and cause migration, thus reducing effectiveness of treatment. Treat new mounds as they appear. For best results, apply when temperatures are 65°-80°F or in the early morning or late evening hours when daytime temperatures are extremely high.

10 pt. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near food or feed products. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

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- e. Revise the second sentence of the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section to read: "Birds and other wildlife feeding on treated areas may be killed." (Underscore indicates added text and should not be reproduced on the label.) (Note: Ciba-Geigy's latest labeling includes the above indicated phrase.)
- f. The last sentence of the directions should be revised. With a misplaced dependent clause, the sentence suggests that the product should be applied in early morning or late evening at a time when the temperatures are extremely high. Revise this sentence to read: "For best results apply when temperatures are 65°-80° F or when daytime temperatures are not extremely high, such as in the early morning or late evening hours."
- e. Insert as the first sentence of the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section:
- "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal."


3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
