### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye injury. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not store near food or feed products. Food utensils such as spoons or measuring cups must not be used for food purposes after use in measuring pesticides. Do not contaminate ornamental fish ponds. Do not allow children or pets on treated areas until granules have been watered into the soil and the grass or soil is dry.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If **swallowed**, call a physician immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing.

If **inhaled**, remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration, if indicated.

If **on skin**, wash promptly with plenty of soap and water. Rinse thoroughly. Get medical attention.

If **in eyes**, rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.

**Note to Physicians:** Emergency Information — call 1-800-457-2022. This is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Birds, especially waterfowl feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Do not exceed maximum permitted label rates. Application rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds and waterfowl. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries.

Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas.

Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where fish, shrimp, crab and other aquatic life are important resources. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment washwaters.

**Spot Treatment—Imported Fire Ants:** To control Imported Fire Ants in home lawns and other outdoor home recreational areas, apply 1/2 cup in a 3 ft. diameter over and around each fire ant mound. Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Do not use more than 2 gallons of water. Apply water gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering may disturb the ants and cause migration, thus reducing effectiveness of treatment. Treat new mounds as they appear. For best results, apply in cool weather, 65 to 80°F., or in the early morning or late evening hours.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area.

**DISPOSAL: PRODUCT—**Partially filled bag may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER—**Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.
