

Now with quick connect sprayer. 1. Pull sprayer from bottle. 2. Pull [color] hose connector and coil from sprayer handle. 3. Insert hose connector into [color] spout on cap until it clicks in place. 4. Flip up spout. Turn sprayer nozzle to open, and spray.

Gives Complete Kill of Tough Weeds in Flower Beds, Around Trees, Shrubs, in Lawns, Walks, Driveways, and Mulch. The weed killer moves systemically through all parts of the plant. Visible results in 24 hours with complete kill in 1 to 2 weeks. This product is a non-selective weed killer and will kill all vegetation contacted.

**HOW TO USE:** Adjust sprayer nozzle to a coarse spray or jet stream. Stand close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with spray nozzle aimed at weed and away from face. Spray to cover center of weed. Do not over spray. Be careful when treating weeds not to spray surrounding desirable grasses or nearby plants as they will also be killed. One application will kill most weeds listed. If tough weeds are not completely controlled within 2 weeks, repeat application. Do not use for spot weed control in lawns. Do not apply when rainfall is expected within 6 hours as weed control will be reduced. If spray accidentally contacts desirable foliage, wash off immediately with water. Ornamental gardens can be reseeded or replanted soon / 1 day after treatment.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

[For conventional trigger sprayers]

**STORAGE:** Rotate nozzle to closed position.

[For larger conventional sprayers] Place trigger sprayer under handle on container to keep sprayer above level of contents.

[For proprietary sprayer and bottle]

**STORAGE:** Flip down spout to close. No need to disconnect trigger sprayer. Rotate nozzle to closed position. Snap sprayer back in place.

Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferable in a locked storage area. Keep from freezing.

**DISPOSAL: PRODUCT-** Partially filled bottle may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER:** Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
