

3. Spray evenly over 2,100 sq ft until jar is empty.

For dallisgrass in Bermuda, blue and zoysia grasses, and dichondra:

Amount to Use: 2 fl oz (4 Tbs) per gallon of water for each 200 sq ft



When using Ortho® Dial 'n Spray®:

1. Set dial to 2 oz.
2. Add 16 fl oz (entire contents) to sprayer jar. DO NOT add water.
3. Spray evenly over 1,600 sq ft until jar is empty.

For cutgrass in Bermuda and zoysia grasses:

Amount to Use: 3 fl oz (6 Tbs) per gallon of water for each 200 sq ft



2. Add 16 fl oz (entire contents) to sprayer jar. DO NOT add water.
3. Spray evenly over 1,000 sq ft until jar is empty.

IMPORTANT

MEASURE

MOW

WATER

 - weeds are small and actively growing

 - Crabgrass and dallisgrass: Wait 7 days between each application.
 - Nutgrass: Wait a month between each application.
- Follow-up sprays may be necessary if new weed seeds sprout.
- Newly planted lawn can be sprayed after second mowing.
- Bare spots in lawns can be planted with grass seed 1 day after application.


