

For control of broadleaved weeds such as Dandelion, Chickweed, Cinquefoil, Clovers, Ground Ivy, Henbit, Knotweed, Wild Onion, Annual Morningglory, Pennywort, Plantain, Poison Ivy, Poison Oak, Purslane, Spotted Spurge, Redstem Filaree, Curly Dock, Mares Tail, Purple Cudweed, Southern Brassbuttons, Scarlet Pimpernel, Florida Pusley, Oxalis, Common Lespedeza, Red Sorrel, Heartleaf Drymary, Bindweed, False Dandelion, Wild Carrot, Narrowleaf Plantain, and Thistles in lawns.

WEED-B-GON Jet Weeder Formula II is formulated for "spot" application to individual weeds.

This spot weeder produces a "foamy" white lather for direct weed contact which avoids drift and marks weeds as treated. (To treat entire lawn, use WEED-B-GON Lawn Weed Killer as a spray.)

DIRECTIONS

1. Shake can just before using and occasionally during use.
2. Invert can, hold at arm's length, and point can at weed as you press button.
Do not press button when can is in upright position.
3. Stand close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with can aimed at weed and away from face.
4. Push down briefly on button. Spray to cover center of weed, do not over-spray.
The spray's foaming action will make it easy for you to see coverage.
5. One application will kill most weeds listed. If certain tough weeds are not dead within 3 weeks, repeat application.

NOTE: Be careful when treating weeds not to spray surrounding desirable grasses unless temporary discoloration can be tolerated. Also avoid spraying or spattering of nearby flowers and other desirable plants.

Do not use on Clover or Dichondra. Bentgrass, St. Augustine or Carpetgrass may be injured by use of this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT - Unused product may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER** - Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
