Subject: Application for Label Amendment for Ortho Indoor Insect Killer EPA Reg. No. 239-2512

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Ingredient Statement. The second active ingredient should read as follows: [3-phenoxybenzyl-(1RS, 3RS; 1RS, 3SR)-2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylprop-1-enyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate. This would bring the label into accord with the Sumithrin registration standard.

Modify the petroleum distillate note to read as follows:
 "Contains petroleum distillate, xylene, or xylene range aromatic solvent."

Storage and Disposal Statement. The Container Disposal Statement is not optional for products intended for homeowner use. It should be modified to read as follows:
 "Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."

Precautionary Statements. Move the following statements to the directions for use:
 Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Modify the precautionary statements to read as follows:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapors. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

First Aid. Modify the First Aid Statement as follows:
If SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid alcohol.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. See a doctor if irritation persists.
IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Physical or Chemical Hazards. Modify this statement to read as follows:
Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° may cause bursting. Do not apply this product to or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of a shock hazard.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, GNATS: Spray areas where pests congregate, especially upper corners, along walls, baseboards, and cracks in woodwork.

ANTS, ROACHES, FLEAS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES: Spray directly on insects and in areas where insect may be found, such as carpets, under sinks, firewood piles, cabinets, cracks and crevices on baseboards, window frames, screens, garbage cans, and other areas where pests may be found.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
