**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** In case of eye contact, wash eyes immediately with fresh water for at least 15 minutes. See a doctor if irritation persists. If this is not possible, telephone for medical advice. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If in area, remove person from exposure area. **Note to Physicians:** Emergency information: call 415-333-3737. Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates and toxic to birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS**

**HOW TO USE:** If ground is dry, water area to be treated thoroughly. While wearing protective gloves, scatter the product on the ground. **DO NOT PUT PRODUCT IN PILES.** Apply 1 lb. of product to each 2,000 sq. ft. Do not apply to foliage or other plant parts. **Always sprinkle lightly with water after application to moisten granules and make them more attractive to snails, slugs and the other listed insects.** Withhold heavy watering for at least 2 days after treatment.

For spring planting, bait areas to prevent damage to transplants or seedlings. Repeat treatment every two weeks or as needed. During periods of high rainfall or frequent irrigation, repeat treatments may be needed more frequently.

Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated areas must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl labels.
