Dear Mr. Chase:

The above mentioned label amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable with the insertion of the Physical or Chemical Hazards statement (Copy A).

The following revisions will also have to be made:

1. The Environmental Hazards statement will have to be changed to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."
2. Change the Storage and Disposal statement to read "Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke."

A stamped copy of your label is enclosed for your records.

Also kills brushy weed species such as Lantana, Elderberry, Pin Oak, Japanese Honeysuckle, Mustang Grape, Oak, Brambles, Blackberry, Chinese Elm, and Peppervine. Can also be used to kill stumps and prevent regrowth from stumps of trees such as Chinaberry, Black Jack Oak, Willow, Persimmon and Elm. A foam marker has been added to aid in the complete coverage of foliage and stems. Rainfall 2 hours after treatment and drying will not wash away effectiveness.

**WHEN TO APPLY**

Apply when vegetation is fully leafed out and actively growing. Apply also to trunks, limbs, and stems of vines. Wilting or other symptoms will occur in 2 to 6 weeks. Application to mature foliage is preferred. Apply only when the air is calm to prevent drift to desirable vegetation. Do not use on or around edible feed or food crops.

5. When poison ivy trunks of trees, spray base and up to above the foliage of dead growing on private plants cut ivy vines.
6. Under ordinary conditions plants leaves turn brown. The chemicals are plant, killing root.

**STUMP KILLING:** Apply 3-6 inches below cut.
