**OPTION # 1 APPLICATOR DIRECTIONS FOR SPRINKLE-POUR SPOUT (1 GAL)**

**[HOW TO APPLY/USE]**

Remove cap and be certain that applicator head is screwed on firmly. Invert jug and apply to thoroughly cover unwanted vegetation. For killing vegetation around trees, shrubs and buildings and edging around lawns, fences and sidewalks, hold the jug about 2 to 6 inches from the area to be treated depending upon desired width. The width of the spray pattern may be adjusted by either raising or lowering the jug. One gallon will cover a band 2 inches wide and 1200 feet long.

For controlling weeds in walks and patios, hold jug at about waist height away from body to avoid contact with skin or clothing. Walk slowly making sure that all weeds are thoroughly covered. Thoroughly cover all cracks and joints in sidewalks, driveways and patios.

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**OPTION # 2 APPLICATOR DIRECTIONS FOR PULL 'N SPRAY (II) (PNSII)

IMPORTANT! Follow directions and illustrations on back to assemble and use Pull 'N Spray correctly.

*[Illustration 1]*

- Remove sprayer from side carrier and unwrap hose completely.
- Insert (color of plug) plug at end of hose into (color of spout) spout on cap until it clicks.
- Flip up spout. Spout must remain up while spraying

*[Illustration 2]*

- Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to desired spray pattern [narrow, medium or wide stream].

*[Illustration 3]*

- Point sprayer away from body.
- Grasp sprayer by the handle.
- Slowly pull ring at bottom of sprayer handle until it stops and hold for two [2] seconds to ready the sprayer.

*[Illustration 4]*

- Press and hold button on sprayer to begin spraying.
- Pull ring at sprayer bottom again as needed to continue spraying.

1. For best results pull out slowly and hold for two [2] seconds.

**OPTION # 3 APPLICATOR DIRECTIONS FOR PULL 'N SPRAY 1 (1 GAL OR 1.33 GAL)**

***[PNS I EPA Required Language]***

***[FRONT PANEL – LARGE TYPE, BOLD FACE]***  
**DO NOTE UNSCREW CAP. DO NOT REFILL CONTAINER.**

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*[Wand Sticker]*

IMPORTANT! Follow directions and illustrations on back to assemble and use Pull 'N Spray correctly.

*[Illustration 1]*

Detach yellow wand and pull plug and tubing from bottom of wand. Insert plug firmly into "T-handle" until it clicks. ONCE CONNECTED, PLUG CANNOT BE REMOVED WITHOUT DAMAGING "T-HANDLE.

*[Illustration 2]*

Slide white strip on cap, then grab "T-handle" and pull all the way up. JUST PULL UP -- NO NEED TO PUMP.

*[Illustration 3]*

Point wand at area to be treated and push button to begin spraying. Twist nozzle at end of wand to adjust spray pattern.

*[Illustration 4]*

Pull "T-handle" again as needed to continue spraying. JUST PULL -- NO NEED TO PUMP. When finished, push "T-handle" gently down to cap and follow storage instructions.
