Intent to submit forestry dissipation data
Amendment: Update label per Registration Standard
Ortho Lindane No. 200 Spray
EPA Reg. No. 239-2518
Your submissions received April 16 and August 5, 1986

A FIFRA section 3(c)(2)(B) Data Call-In Notice for lindane end-use products with directions for forestry use was issued June 11, 1986. The Environmental Protection Agency has determined that you have complied with the requirements of that Notice by submitting a FIFRA section 3(c)(2)(B) Summary Sheet, indicating that you will submit the required forestry dissipation study in a timely manner (i.e. within the allowed time frame of 27 months from the date of your receipt of the June 11, 1986 Data Call-In Notice), within the 30 day time period allowed.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided the following revisions are made prior to release for shipment under the amended label:

1. The directions for use for pine bark beetles should be expanded and clarified. Specifically, do the directions indicate us on fresh cut logs or standing trees? If standing trees are indicated, to what height should the trunk be sprayed? What type of application equipment is appropriate? When should the application be made? Should a repeat application be made within a given season? If so, what should be the interval between applications? It is strongly recommended that you consult the Lindane Registration Standard, other pine bark beetle control product labels, and,

especially, the USDA Forest Service (which will be conducting the required study), for assistance in expanding your directions for use on pine bark beetles. Please contact Mr. Dennis Hammel of the USDA Forest Service at 202-235-8209.

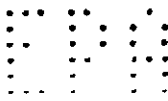
2. Revise the Environmental Hazards text from "Do not apply directly to water." to "Do not apply to water or wetlands." Also, add "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes." as the last sentence of this same section.
3. Add "Contains Xylene" under the ingredients statement, in the same location as the current "Lindan per gallon: 1.65 lbs."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Please submit five (5) copies of the revised amended label prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling.

It should be noted that future revisions to the label may be required, based upon the Agency's review of data submitted in response to the Lindane Registration Standard and any associated 3(c)(2)(B) Data Call-In Notices.
