

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS 12 pt.**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**WARNING 12 pt.**

**GLADIOLUS AND DAFFODIL BULBS:** Wireworms—Dust dry bulbs during time of planting with 2 to 3 oz. to each 100 lbs. bulbs for temporary protection while rooting.

**USE ON ANIMALS**

Do not treat animals under 3 months of age. Do not spray beef cattle, sheep, goats and hogs within 30 days of slaughter. Do not dip them within 60 days of slaughter. Do not treat sows within 2 weeks of farrowing nor for at least 3 weeks thereafter. Do not use on dairy cattle or dair, goats. Avoid treating animals in cold, stormy weather. Do not dip or spray thirsty, overheated or sick animals. Using dosages given below, spray entire animal or infested areas as necessary in following amounts. Adult Animals (Horses, Cattle): 2 qts. diluted spray per head, using proportionately lesser amounts for smaller animals. Use at from 300 to 400 lbs. pressure. Young animals (those over 3 months of age): 1 qt. diluted spray per animal. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling the concentrate or applying the diluted product to animals.

**BEEF CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS, HOGS, HORSES:** Spray or Dip—psoroptic and Sarcoptic Mange (Scab or Scabies)—1½ lbs. per 100 gals. water. For most effective treatment, apply 2 sprays one week apart. Do not use on sick animals. Lice, Ticks, Horn Flies, Stable Flies—1 lb. per 100 gals. water. Sheep Ticks (Keds) on Sheep—1½ lbs. in 100 gals. water. Spray along back and around ears, spraying against wool. Spray in fall. In some areas a repeat treatment after shearing is also advisable. About 350 lbs. pressure is desirable.
