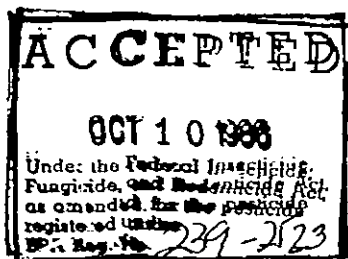

DIRECTIONS

SHAKE BEFORE USING. Point valve opening away from face and push button, holding container as upright as possible. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

NOTE: Do not contaminate food, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums when using indoors.

How To Use: Fleas and Ticks — Cats and Dogs — Holding upright container 8-12 inches from pet, start spraying at tail, moving the container rapidly to ensure complete coverage of back, legs and underside. Ruffle hair to insure good coverage and penetration to the skin. Do not spray into eyes, face or on genital areas. Apply to animal to thoroughly moisten hair. To prevent reinfestation, remove soiled pet bedding and wash or destroy, then spray entire inside surface of dog house. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after spray has dried. Repeat as necessary.

Note: This aerosol makes a slight hissing sound and causes a temporary cool sensation. Hold pet securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used but soon become accustomed to the treatment.

FOR RESIDUAL CONTROL IN AND AROUND PET QUARTERS — Use ORTHO Home Pest Insect Control.

ANTS, ROACHES, FLEAS, SPIDERS (including Black Widow Spiders), **EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES:** Spray directly on insects wherever possible and in areas where insects may be found; such as in carpets, under sinks, firewood piles, drainboards, cabinets, cracks, and crevices on baseboards, pipes, around doorsills, window frames, screens, garbage cans, refuse areas, in attics, behind shelving, bookcases, storage areas and other areas where pests may be found. Repeat as necessary.

INDOORS — FOR PROTECTION OF STORED GARMENTS AND FABRICS (Wool, Cotton and Synthetic): Dry clean or wash garments and blankets before treating. Clean carpets, and other fabrics by thoroughly brushing before treating. To move persistent spots or stains by dry cleaning. Apply treatments, blankets, carpets and other fabrics only before in storage for protection from larvae of webbing clothing and black carpet beetles. Hold the container 14 inches to 18 inches from the fabric and apply the spray while moving evenly in a forward and backward motion across the fabric while covering one-foot-per-foot motion. Spray the entire fabric surface until it is slightly moist to the touch. When possible treat both sides of the fabric. Do not soak or wet fabric. For maximum protection place treated fabrics after drying in plastic bags. Also treat cracks and crevices of closets, chests and trunks where these fabrics are stored. Treat the cracks and crevices at the rate of two ounces per linear foot. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing. When applied as directed on fabric and in storage a single treatment will offer protection for 6 months. To insure protection repeat application every 6 months. (Treated fabrics should not be put in a darkened closet or other darkened storage area for heavy applications. When possible make application outdoors. If application is made indoors do not remain in treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is complete.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL: PRODUCT—Unused product may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of paper and discard in trash.
CONTAINER—Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
