



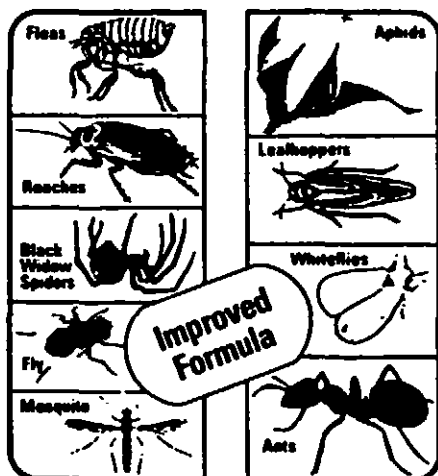

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

INDOORS—To Kill Fleas, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats, Bees and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, and Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders): Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cr., l.s., hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, spray directly on ants and trail doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Confused Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves after the spray has dried. Repeat as necessary. **To Kill Sawflies, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and launder old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not use animals with this product. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Treat dog and cats with FLEA-B-GON Flea Killer before allowing them to enter treated areas.

OUTDOORS—To Reduce Annoyance of Houseflies, Gnats and Small Flies—Mosquitoes: Spray areas infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests from open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

General: Spray directly on insects when possible.

Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants. Holding aerosol can too close to foliage may result in overwatering and damage to tender foliage. **HOLD CAN 18 INCHES FROM PLANT.** Spray at first signs of pests, before infestation is heavy. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals when insect populations occur. Spray in the morning or evening when air is still, not in the heat of midday or when temperature exceeds 90°F. Do not apply to wind-blown plants.

Controls: Eastern Tent Caterpillar, Aphids, Caterpillars, Leafhopper, Lacebugs, Whiteflies, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetle, Mealybug, Ants, and Caterpillars on Ornamental Cherry, Spruce, Rose, Grape Myrtle, Ornamental Crabapple, Andromeda, Azalea, Chrysanthemum, Gardenia, Purple Passion Vine, Peony, Oleander and Arbutus.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT—Unused product may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER—**Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
