

GRASS-B-GON Grass Killer is a ready-to-use selective systemic grass killer that can be used to kill existing weedy grasses in and around plant beds, landscapes and individual shrubs and trees. Treatment is rain proof one hour after application.

### WEEDY GRASSES CONTROLLED

Controls most annual and hard-to-kill perennial grasses including the examples listed below in one (or two) application(s). Younger, actively growing seedling weeds are more easily killed than older, mature, well-established grassy weeds.

Note: This product does not control broadleaf weeds or sedges (nutgrass). Select an appropriate KLEENUP or WEED-B-GON product.

WHEN TO APPLY—Apply anytime weeds are actively growing. Warm, sunny weather will accelerate systemic movement from leaves and stems down to the roots to give complete kill. Do not mow or cut off tops of weeds before spraying. Do not apply if rainfall is expected within one hour. Growth of treated grasses stops soon after application. They turn yellow and die within one to four weeks depending on the grass species and weather conditions. Cool weather slows activity.

HOW TO USE—Apply with a hand tagger sprayer. Sprayer nozzle should be adjusted to deliver a fine spray pattern to just wet foliage. Stand close to weed (1-2 feet) with spray nozzle aimed at weed and away from face. Make two applications 7 days apart for tough to control weeds. Repeat if necessary. Spray when air is calm to avoid drift to nonlabeled plants. If an unlisted plant is accidentally contacted, wash off immediately with water. Unless the ornamental plant is listed in the table below under those plants which you can spray over the top, always direct the spray to the weeds to avoid possible injury to the foliage.
