### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquarium before space spraying or surface applications.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED:** Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS.

**HOW TO USE:** Shake well before using. Fold back protective hinged tab exposing nozzle. Snap in place an sprayer top. Hold container about 12 inches from animal or surface to be treated. May be used indoors or outdoors.

**FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS AND CATS:** Start spraying at the animal's head — avoiding the eyes, nose and mouth as you spray. Make sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs, under body and tail. While spraying, fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Spray contains a fragrance that leaves animal smelling fresh. Repeat as necessary.

**PET AREAS:** To control fleas and brown dog ticks on premises: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet bedding, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** For storage, reseal by replacing tab closure over spray nozzle. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. **DISPOSAL: PRODUCT** — Partially filled bottle may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER** — Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
