As per our January 29, 1988 telephone conversation, efficacy data are needed on adults of squash bug, flea beetle, green stinkbug, and leafhoppers. These data should be submitted at the end of the 1988 growing season.

HOW TO USE: Shake well before using. Fold back protective hinged tab exposing nozzle. Snap into place on sprayer top. Apply when insects or first signs of damage appear. Spray to wet all infested plant surfaces. For aphids spray again if insects return. For spidermites and scale, apply weekly being sure to spray undersides of leaves. For cabbage worms, flea beetles, squashbugs, green stink bugs, lacebugs and leafhoppers, spray directly on insect when present.

May be used up to day of harvest.

Kills: Aphids, Whitefly, Squash Bug, Green Stink Bug, Leafhoppers, Cabbage worm, Flea Beetle, Lace Bugs and Spider Mites.

PLANTS: Beans, Broccoli, Broccoli Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Cucumbers, Egg Plant, Lettuce, Melons, Okra, Peas, Peppers, Potatoes, Pumpkins, Radish, Summer Squash (Zucchini), Butternut (Zucchini) and Tomatoes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: For storage, reveal by replacing tab closure over spray nozzle. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put in refrigerator or into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of food and food stuffs. Store in a cool, dry place preferably in a locked storage area.
