
4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS AND CATS: Starting at the tail, work dust thoroughly into the hair including the legs, under body and tail. Avoid contact with eyes, nose, mouth and genitalia. While dusting, fluff the hair so that dust will penetrate to the skin. Dust contains a fragrance that leaves animal smelling fresh. Repeat as necessary.

PET AREAS: To control fleas and brown dog ticks on premises: Lightly dust infested areas, pet bedding, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. **DISPOSAL: PRODUCT** - Partially filled canister may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER** - Do not reuse canister. Discard canister in trash.
