FLEA AND TICK CONTROL (OUTDOORS)

FORM ACCEPTED BY EPA

In warm summer months, fleas and ticks frequently become established in lawns and pet resting areas surrounding the home. To control these harmful pests, it is necessary to follow a regular treatment program. Treat once a month beginning when pests first appear in late spring (May - June) and continue until late summer (September - October). Fall temperatures below 50°F help to reduce the severity of these pests. Eliminating weeds around the home and mowing lawns frequently reduces hiding places.

Note: Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered product such as ORTHO Pet Flea & Tick Spray Formula II. In addition, if fleas or ticks are indoors on carpets or pet resting areas, use a product such as FLEA-B-GON Flea & Tick Killer or ORTHO Home Pest Insect Control. It is very important that all three sites - outdoors, indoors and also the pet be treated with appropriate labeled products to achieve satisfactory control. If any one of these areas is infested, it can serve as a source of reinfestation to the entire premises.

HOME INVADING PESTS

PERIMETER TREATMENT AROUND FOUNDATION (OUTSIDE)

The following pests are commonly found around or near the foundation of houses. Many of these insects will enter home seeking food and shelter.

Ants	Crickets	Fleas	Brown Dog Ticks
Earwigs	Clover Mites	Sowbugs	Millipedes
Spiders (Incl. Black Widow Spiders)	Cockroaches	(Pillbugs)	Silverfish

To control and prevent entry of the above pests, apply this product in a band 2-6 feet wide around and adjacent to the building using an ORTHO Whirlybird Hand Spreader when pests are active and may find entrance. Thoroughly treat garbage can storage areas, outdoor pet resting areas, around dog houses and pet "bathroom" areas. Do not treat pets with this product. See table below for coverage.

Note: ORTHO Whirlybird Hand Spreader (one level hopperful holds 1½ pounds of product).
