ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS: Spray heavily into all cracks and behind baseboards. When insects run out, spray them. Repeat treatment as required.

BLACK WIDOW AND OTHER SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, HOUSE CENTIPEDES: Spray spider webs, around windows, back of shutters and rainspouts, corners of garages and basements. Treat window frames and other entry points.

SILVERFISH: Spray crevices along baseboards in attic and basement areas. Remove books, spray bookcases, permit to dry before returning books. Treat back and beneath bookcases.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray crevices along wood trim around doors and windows, baseboards, etc. Spray all crevices and floor areas where dog rests. Treat areas in porch and dog kennels. Fresh bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray pets. Repeat as necessary.

FLIES, MAGGOTS: To aid in keeping garbage cans free of flies and maggots, spray inside and outside frequently.

For use in or around the home, restaurants and food handling establishments. Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants and other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Avoid contamination of food utensils and food preparation areas.

Remove bird cages and cover fish aquaria while spraying.

Do not spray asphalt tile, some linoleum, carpets with attached foam backing and certain plastics. Tile adhesives may be loosened if over treated. Do not spray radio or TV cabinets.
