Your Application Dated April 25, 1996.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided you make the following changes:

1. Revise the Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals, after the word "APPLYING:" in the third line of this section, to comply with requirements for products containing 2,4-D and MCPP. The revised text should read:

"When using this product wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, rubber gloves and eye protection. After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower. Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried."

Note: We have no objection if you wish to require users to wear "chemical-resistant", rather than "waterproof", gloves; however, chemical-resistant gloves are not required for this type of 2,4-D product.

2. Revise the ocular and oral First Aid statements to conform to the Agency's guidance in the Label Review Manual. Since the product is classified in Toxicity Category II, based on eye irritation potential, these statements should read as follows:
