

**WHEN TO APPLY:** Apply when vegetation is leafed out and growing. For best results, apply to mature leaves. Apply only when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable vegetation. Rainfall within 24 hours may reduce effectiveness.

**HOW TO USE**

Shake before using. Adjust sprayer nozzle to a coarse spray for treatment of unwanted vegetation.

Stand close to weed (1 to 2 ft). Aim nozzle at weed and away from face. Be careful not to spray desirable lawn grasses, groundcovers, or plants as they may be killed. If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, wash them immediately with water. Wilting or other symptoms (i.e. yellowing) will occur in two to six weeks.

Hard-to-control plants, such as Poison Oak, Poison Ivy, Blackberries, and Honeysuckle may require retreatment the following season if regrowth occurs.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not allow spray to contact desirable vegetation or ornamental plants as injury may result.

**NOTE:** For treating in larger areas, use BRUSH-B-GON Brush Killer, a concentrated product.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Rotate nozzle to closed position. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. Keep from freezing.

**DISPOSAL: PRODUCT** - Partially filled bottle may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER** - Do not reuse empty bottle. Wrap container and put in trash.
