2. Under the heading Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, delete the following text:

"This product may cause skin sensitization reaction in some people."

3. Place the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals heading and related text on the front panel of the product label or provide an explanation why this text cannot be placed on the front panel.

4. On page two, the phrase "other non-crop areas" is too broad. Revise to read as follows:

Gives complete control of poison ivy and poison oak on non-crop areas around homes, cabins, buildings, fences, and trails.

5. On page two, revise as follows: Do not use around edible feed or food crop **or areas where grazing is allowed.**


6. A substatement within the ingredient statement that indicates the weight of acid equivalency per unit volume (lb ae triclopyr/gal product) must be included.

7. A maximum application rate of 9 lbs ae/A can be converted to square feet) must be specified (oz product/sq feet should be included in parentheses).

8. As part of the reregistration process, the basic confidential statement of formula (CSF) must be amended to reflect the current company name and address of registrant.

Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments". This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.
