PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Shake can well before using.

For best results, use throughout the growing season to prevent buildups of insect infestations. Spray plants from a distance of 1 1/2 to 2 feet using short bursts of 1 second. To prevent injury to plants, avoid visibly wetting the foliage.

Apply in the early morning or late evening when the air is still, treating all foliage with particular attention to the undersides of leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days or as reinfestation occurs.

This insecticide may be used outdoors in gardens or in greenhouses throughout the growing season or as a pre-harvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

To control insects named, apply this spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatments as needed to control infestations. May be applied on day of harvest.


