Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames except pilot lights. Keep can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights. Close outside doors and windows. Use one can for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (625 sq. ft., 25 ft. x 25 ft. of floor space with a standard 8 ft. ceiling). Use additional units for larger areas or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not overapply. Do not use in small enclosed areas. Do not remain in the areas being treated. Ventilate thoroughly before re-occupying treated areas.

Note: Asphalt tile and some plastics may be affected by this product. Place newspapers on asphalt tile before treatment and cover plastic items such as plastic furniture, stereo covers, eyeglasses, etc.

For Total Release: Shake container. Cover a stand or table with several layers of newspapers (to prevent marring surface) and place in the center of area to be treated. Point valve opening away from face. Press valve actuator on top of can all the way down, locking the catch. Then place fogger on newspaper-covered stand with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed

for four hours. Open all doors and windows, then leave treated area and allow to air out for 30 more minutes. Repeat treatment as necessary for new insect reinfestations.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas In Pet Sleeping Quarters: Remove and thoroughly wash pet's old bedding or destroy and replace with clean, fresh bedding. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product such as ORTHO Pet Flea and Tick Spray prior to reentering treated premises.
