This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) since you have agree to:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 239-2626" before you release the product for shipment.

b. Delete the statement "Causes eye irritation." from the Precautionary Statements.

c. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 to 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

d. Add the following to the Precautionary Statements:

All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

e. The flammability of aerosol cans is currently being considered under the FR Notice of February 20, 1991 (Vol. 56, No. 34) entitled "Pesticide Aerosol Flammability; Solicitation of Comments." Until Agency policy concerning this issue is final, the following statements should be added to the use directions of all total release product labels:

Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

f. Delete the section beginning "Product - Unused product may be disposed..." and revise the Disposal statement to read:

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate, puncture or discard in home trash compactor.

g. Delete Hi-Power from the product name. Refer to PR-Notice 91-7 for more information in this regard.

h. Change "For Home Use Only" to "For Residential Use Only."

3. Submit 5 copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

TO CONTROL: Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Yellow Jackets, Flies, Spiders, Mosquitoes, Confused Flour Beetles, Small Flying Moths, Rice Weevils and Sawtoothed Grain beetles follow instructions below.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames except pilot lights, (Keep can at least 6 feet away from pilot lights). Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space (25 ft. x 25 ft. room with a standard 8 ft. ceiling). Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. **IMPORTANT:** Do not remain in the building during treatment and ventilate thoroughly (30 minutes) before reentry.

FOR TOTAL RELEASE

To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open. Place fogger on several layers of newspaper to prevent marring of surface. Leave treatment area at orcc and keep area closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air (30 minutes). Repeat application when necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Old pet bedding should be removed before treatment and replaced with fresh, clean bedding after treatment. Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control on animals such as FLEA-B-GON® Flea Killer (aerosol) or ORTHO Pet Flea & Tick Spray (pump spray). For severe infestations, additional treatment may be necessary.

SUGGESTION: For residual control of crawling pests such as roaches, earwigs, ants, spiders, silverfish, etc. use HI-POWER® Ant, Roach & Spider Spray or ORTHO Home Pest Insect Control or FLEA-B-GON® Flea & Tick Killer prior to using this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT - Unused product may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER - Replace cap and discard empty container in trash. Do not incinerate, puncture or discard in home trash compactor.
