Dear Mr. Levey:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements section to read: "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse." Delete the statements "In case of...if irritation persists."

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. If you have any questions, please call Dr. William Sproat of my team at 703-308-8587.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. DO NOT use in a room 5 ft. X 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with pilot lights.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE/USING. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT & POINTED AWAY FROM FACE.

1. PREPARE AREA: cover and store food, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors in area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Turn off all ignition sources, as listed in Directions for Use. Remove pets, birds, cover fish aquariums and exposed foods before spraying. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.
2. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space (25 ft x 25 ft room with a standard 8 ft ceiling).

TO CONTROL: Ants Cockroaches, Crickets, Yellow Jackets, Flies, Spiders, Mosquitoes, Confused Flour Beetles, Small Flying Moths, Rice Weevils and Sawtoothed Grain Beetles follow instructions below.

[Re-entry Icon] IMPORTANT: Do not remain in the building during treatment and ventilate thoroughly (30 minutes) before reentry.

Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table.
Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

FOR TOTAL RELEASE: To lock valve in open position, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room on several layers of

newspaper to prevent marring of surface. Leave treatment area at once and keep area closed for four hours before airing out. After 4 hours open all doors and windows and allow to air (30 minutes) before returning to area. Repeat application when needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame.

[OPTION 1]

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where aerosol can recycling is available.
