

#### HOW IT WORKS

**KLEERAWAY<sup>™</sup>** Concentrated Weed & Grass Killer controls weeds, grasses, and other vegetation along fences, patios, paths, sidewalks and driveways, around trees, shrubs and ornamental plantings, around buildings, and in brick and gravel walkways. When applied to plants, it is absorbed by the leaves and moves throughout the stem and roots to kill the entire plant. Visible effects generally occur within 3 days with complete kill in 2 to 4 weeks. KLEERAWAY is broken down in the soil by microbes. Once in contact with soil, it has no more weed killing activity and will not move in or on the soil to affect nearby plants. Lawns and gardens can be reseeded or planted soon after treatment.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label. Use only in accordance with label directions and precautionary statements.

#### WHEN TO APPLY

Apply when vegetation is green and actively growing. For best results, apply on a sunny day when the daytime temperature is at least 60°F. Warm, sunny weather will speed up weed control. Do not use if rain is expected within 8 hours of application or weed control may be reduced. Thick lawn grass or hard-to-control weeds (such as Bermudagrass) may require a repeat application. Apply only when the air is calm.

#### HOW TO APPLY

To apply with a plastic, aluminum or stainless steel tank-type sprayer, or Ortho hose-end sprayers refer to Mixing Instructions below to determine the correct amount of KLEERAWAY and water to add to sprayer. **Note:** Do not use or store in galvanized or unlined steel sprayers.

ORTHO DIAL 'n SPRAY <sup>®</sup> Hose-End Sprayer	2 cups (1 pint) of KLEERAWAY into sprayer jar. Set sprayer dial on 8 oz. Do not add water to sprayer jar.	500 sq ft

Spray weeds until foliage is wet. Avoid overspraying that results in runoff. Thoroughly rinse all application equipment when finished spraying. People and pets may reenter treated areas after sprayed vegetation has dried.

**IMPORTANT:** Use a tank-type sprayer for spot treatments. Spray carefully. Avoid spray or drift contact with desirable lawn grasses, shrubs or trees. This product can kill or damage all vegetation contacted. If accidental spray contacts desirable plant foliage, immediately rinse the foliage with water.

#### WHERE TO APPLY

**For General Weed Control:** Apply along fences, paths, patios, sidewalks and driveways, around trees, shrubs, and ornamental plantings, around buildings, and in brick and gravel walkways. Use to trim and edge landscape areas, but not recommended for spot weed control in lawns.

**For Landscaping:** Apply in areas where planting of ornamentals, trees, shrubs, desert landscapes, rock gardens, flower beds or similar plantings will be made.

**For Ornamentals:** Apply around ornamentals, trees, or shrubs. Spray contact other than with mature bark of desirable plants may cause injury.

**For Lawn Renovation:** Use to eliminate old, undesirable, or weed infested lawns or to change to a more desirable grass type. For best results, skip at least one mowing prior to spraying. Delay reseeding, tilling, or seeding for 7 days after spraying.

**For Vegetables, Small Fruits and Berries:** The following vegetables, small fruits and berries may be planted (by seed, rooted cuttings or transplant) 7 days after spraying. For unlisted vegetables, small fruits and berries, wait 30 days after spraying to plant.

**VEGETABLES:** Jerusalem Artichoke, Asparagus, Beans, Beet Greens, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cantaloupe, Carrot, Cauliflower, Casaba Melon, Celery, Chard (Swiss), Chicory, Chard, Corn, Cress, Watermelon, Cucumber, Eggplant, Endive, Garlic, Gourds, Ground Cherry, Honeyflew Melon, Honey Ball Melon, Horseradish, Kale, Kohlrabi, Leek, Lentil, Lettuce, Mango Melon, Melons, Muskmelon, Mustard Greens, Okra, Onion, Rape Greens, Parsley, Parsnips, Peas, Pepper, Persian Melon, Potato (Irish, Sweet), Pumpkin, Radish, Rhubarb, Rutabaga, Spinach, Squash (Summer, Winter), Tomato, Tomato\*, Turnip, Watercress, Watermelon, and Yams.

\*Tomatoes planted from seed only. Wait 30 days for rooted transplants.

**SMALL FRUITS AND BERRIES:** Blackberry, Blueberry, Boysenberry, Cranberry, Currant, Dewberry, Elderberry, Gooseberry, Huckleberry, Loganberry, Highberry, Raspberry (Black & Red), and Strawberry.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

(Statement for smaller-sized containers.)

Store product only in original container in a safe place. Keep from freezing. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

(Statement for larger-sized containers.)

Store product only in its original container, in a secured storage area. Keep from freezing. Only purchase as much product as you need to avoid disposing of partially filled containers. Try to use all of the product or give to someone who will use it. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
