How To Use:

- Adjust spray nozzle to give a coarse spray.
- Aim at center of weed and spray to wet.
- Spray any time weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when rain or temperatures over 85 F are expected within 24 hours.
- Hard to control weeds may require repeat application in 2-3 weeks.
- Newly seeded lawns may be sprayed after lawn has been mowed 3 times.

IMPORTANT:

- Do not use this product for controlling weeds in vegetable gardens, flower beds or around shrubs or ornamental plants.
- Temporary discoloration may occur on sensitive lawns grasses such as hybrid bermudagrass or St. Augustine.
