Use on driveways and walkways, or around fences, trees, flower beds, shrubs and other areas in your yard. Roundup kills weeds by stopping the production of a substance found only in plants. Any Roundup not absorbed by the plant breaks down into natural materials. Roundup will not move in or on the soil to untreated plants.

WHEN TO USE: Use anytime weeds and grasses are actively growing. Treated weeds usually show initial symptoms within hours and complete kill in 1 to 2 weeks. Larger more established weeds may take up to 4 weeks for a complete kill. Roundup works best in warm sunny weather with daytime temperature above 60°F. Reapply if it rains within 6 hours after application. If hard-to-control weeds are not killed within 4 weeks, reapply.

HOW TO USE: To treat individual weeds adjust the nozzle to a coarse spray. Spray when air is calm. Position sprayer tip approximately 1 to 2 feet from weeds and apply until completely covered. **IMPORTANT:** Roundup is an all-purpose weed and grass killer which will kill almost all plants contacted. If necessary, use cardboard or plastic to shield desirable plants. If plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse off immediately with water. Do NOT use for spot weed control in lawns since Roundup kills all green plants, including lawn grass. Sprayed areas can be replanted with ornamentals or flowers the day after treatment. **REUSE AND REFILL INSTRUCTIONS:** To refill: Add 1/8 cup (7 fl oz) of Roundup Concentrate Weed & Grass Killer or 6 Tablespoons (3 fl oz) of Roundup Super Concentrate Weed & Grass Killer to this empty 128 fl oz bottle. Then add 128 fl oz (1 gal) clean tap water and use according to the label directions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Flip down spout to close. **NO NEED TO DISCONNECT TRIGGER SPRAYER.** Close nozzle on trigger sprayer. Snap sprayer back in place. Store this product in its original container, in a secure area. Protect container from freezing. **DISPOSAL:** To dispose of partially used or empty container, securely wrap it in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. In case of SPILL or LEAK, soak up with paper towels and discard in trash. Do not reuse empty container except for refill in accordance with refill instructions.
