

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read the entire label before using this product. Use only according to label instructions.

## WHEN TO USE

Apply when weeds are actively growing. For best results, apply on a sunny day when daytime temperature is at least 60° F. Apply only when the air is calm. Warm, sunny weather will speed up weed control. Reapply if it rains within 6 hours of application. Hard-to-control weeds (such as bermudagrass) may require a repeat application, if they regrow.

## HOW TO USE

Adjust the nozzle to a coarse spray. Position sprayer tip approximately 1 - 2 feet from the weed. Spray weeds until foliage is wet. [11/20/97 Notification] ~~Avoid overspraying that results in runoff.~~ Flowers or ornamentals may be reseeded or replanted into treated areas the next day.
