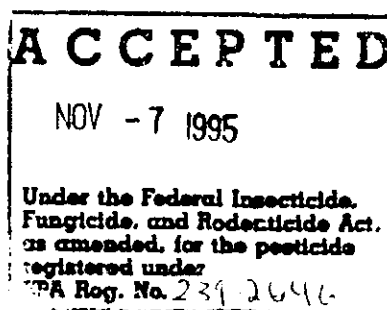

Roundup® Ready-To-Use Weed & Grass Killer<sup>2</sup> when absorbed by contacted foliage, is carried throughout the stems and roots to give complete kill of tough annual and perennial weeds and grasses. Roundup is broken down in the soil by microbes. Once in contact with soil, it has no weed killing activity and will not move in or on the soil to affect nearby vegetation.

### **HOW TO USE:**

**IMPORTANT:** This product is an all-purpose weed and grass killer which can injure or kill all plants contacted. **APPLY ONLY WHEN THE AIR IS CALM. AVOID SPRAY CONTACT ON DESIRABLE PLANTS.** If necessary, shield desirable plants to prevent contact with spray. If spray or drift accidentally contacts desirable vegetation, wash off immediately with water. Rainfall within 6 hours could affect performance. Avoid mowing, cutting or otherwise disturbing sprayed vegetation for at least 7 days. People and pets should stay off sprayed area until thoroughly dry to ensure that product is not tracked into areas where desirable plants are growing.

For spot application adjust the nozzle to a coarse spray. Position sprayer tip approximately 1-2 feet from weeds, grasses, and undesirable plants, and apply until completely covered. Sprayed plants usually show effects within one week with complete kill in 2 to 4 weeks. For best results, apply to actively growing weeds, grasses and undesirable plants in warm sunny weather. If certain hard-to-control weeds are not completely killed within 4 weeks, repeat application. Sprayed areas can be reseeded or replanted, 7 or more days after application.

**WEEDS CONTROLLED:** Roundup Ready-To-Use will completely kill most tough annual weeds, grasses and any undesirable plants found in and around fences,

trees, driveways, flower beds, walkways and shrubs.
