Where to Use

Use [GroundClear] where new growth is not wanted for at least a year, such as on driveways, parking lots, brick walks, gravel pathways, patios, along fences, curbs and cracks in sidewalks. DO NOT use on lawns, on or around fruits, vegetables, flowers, or other plants, or over the root zone of shrubs or trees. (See next page for details.)

To kill weeds in areas where you want other plants to grow, use a product such as Roundup. Follow all directions on product label.

For Best Results

- 1. Water the day before application if soil is dry.
- 2. Apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting. [If weeds are taller than 6 inches, cut back and apply to regrowth.]
- 3. Apply when daytime temperature is at least 60° F.
- 4. Calculate square feet of area to be treated by multiplying length times width. (walking man icon).
- 5. Apply evenly following the listed coverage rate. Allow product to soak into ground, avoiding surface runoff to nearby desirable plants.
- 6. After application, withhold watering for 2-3 days, then water.
- 7. To prevent the growth of weeds under asphalt driveways, tennis courts, playgrounds, and parking lots, apply before laying surfacing materials.
- 8. Rain within 6 hours of application may reduce control of existing weeds, but will not reduce control of germinating seeds. In areas of heavy rainfall, applications every 6 to 8 months may be necessary.

Picture of Fence:
