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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

How to Spray

Shake well before use. Adjust spray nozzle to deliver a stream for cracks and crevices or a coarse spray for other areas. Hold sprayer 12 inches from the insect or surface being sprayed. Use only for spot treatment. [Do not spray into the air]. Spray until slightly wet without soaking. Use only for spot treatment. Do not allow this product to contact food, foodstuffs, food preparation areas or utensils and water supplies.

III.
