Spray dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards, beneath and behind refrigerators, stoves, sinks and cabinets, around plumbing, and around doors and window frames.

Pantry Pests
(Confused flour beetle, granary weevil, Indian meal moth, red flour beetle, rice weevil, saw-toothed grain beetle and roaches)

- Remove all items from pantries and clean pantries thoroughly.
- Spray cracks and crevices along shelves in pantries.
- Replace non-infested items after spray has dried.

Fleas & Ticks

- Spot treat infested areas such as pet resting quarters and localized areas of floor coverings where pests may be present.
- Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of the pet area. **DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** To control the source of flea infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should themselves be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

Ants (including carpenter ants, and harvester ants), boxelder bugs, centipedes, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, fleas, flies (including houseflies), grasshoppers, millipedes, mosquitoes, moths, roaches, scorpions, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders (including black widow and brown recluse spiders, and daddy long legs) and ticks (including ticks that transmit Lyme Disease).

Spray garbage cans and garbage areas, window frames and doorways, porches and patios, eaves, exterior siding, foundations, and localized infestations in weeds or around ornamental plants.

HOW TO SPRAY

Point wand away from body. Unscrew nozzle on wand to deliver a narrow or wide spray. Pull up on handle - **DO NOT PUMP.** Hold wand 12 inches from the insect or surface being sprayed. Use only for spot treatment. Do not spray into the air. Spray until slightly wet without soaking. Exposed food (including pet food) must be covered or removed during application. All food processing surfaces and utensils must be covered during application and thoroughly washed with soap and water before reuse. Do not allow this product to contact water supplies.

People and pets may enter treated areas after spray has dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: To store, make sure handle is all the way down. Slide lock to close. **DO NOT DISCONNECT WAND FROM HANDLE.** Snap wand back in place. Store this product in original container, in a secure area. Protect container from freezing. **DISPOSAL:** To dispose of a partially used or empty container, securely wrap it in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. In case of **SPILL** or **LEAK**, soak up with paper towels and discard in trash. Do not reuse empty container.


