

HOW TO SPRAY/APPLY [optional icon]

- Adjust spray nozzle to deliver a fine spray.
- Hold sprayer 12 inches from plant. Spray to uniformly cover upper and/& lower leaf surfaces, stems and/& branches. When treating potted plants lightly spray the soil surface.

WHEN TO APPLY [optional icon]

- Spray when air is calm to avoid drift.
- Apply as necessary, waiting 7-10 days between applications. Hard to control/kill pests/insects may require 2 to 3 applications.
- If temperature is expected to exceed 85° F spray in early morning or late afternoon when it is cooler [and dew has evaporated.]
