In any correspondence on this product always refer to the above EPA registration number.</p> <p>On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.</p> <p>Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.</p> <p>This product is <u>conditionally</u> registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that you:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make the following labeling changes: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 239-2678" b) Either delete all "Repeat as necessary" - type statements from your label or qualify by stating the minimum allowable time interval between applications. This should be based on the efficacy data cited in support of your product and the duration claims currently claimed. c) When applying to cracks and crevices, baseboards, storage areas, etc., please add the statement "Spray until the surface is just damp, but not to the point of run-off. Avoid excess application."

- d) Please revise your "Statement of Practical Treatment" in accordance with PR Notice 2000-3:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

- e) We could not find any cited efficacy data in your data matrix for Brown Dog Ticks, Cockroaches, Fleas, Flies, and Mosquitoes and to support the front panel statements of "Kills on contact", "Kills carpenter ants on contact", "Guaranteed to kill on contact", "Kills ants up to 8 weeks", and "Kills up to 8 weeks". Please submit or have MGK cite (with MRID numbers) accepted data for all of the above insects with your final printed labeling or remove them from your label.
- f) On page 3 of your label, what "extension tube" are you referring to in the statement "Spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices (use an extension tube)? Does this come with your packaging? If not, please delete.
- g) On page 3 of your label, under "How to Use", please add the statement "For Spot/Crack and Crevice Treatment only. Do not use as space spray"
- h) Please note that you will only be able to keep your "New Formula" and "New and Improved Formula" claims for 6 months following Notice of Registration.

- i) Please remove "Pantry" from your front panel claims of "Can be used in kitchen and pantry" and "Use in kitchen and pantry". Additionally, please omit "Food Storage Areas from "Where To Use". Under "Where To Use" please add a bullet that states "Do not spray in cabinets where food is stored". This is to prevent contamination of food.
 - j) On the last page of your label, under "Notice", please remove "Federal regulations prohibit CFC propellants in aerosols" and the logo "Contains no CFC which deplete the Ozone layer" and "No CFCs". In accordance with PR Notice 92-2 you may put the statement "Contains no CFCs or other ozone depleting substances. Federal regulations prohibit CFC propellants in aerosols".
 - k) Your CSF has been approved. Your product is toxicologically similar to EPA Reg. No. 1021-1608 and the acute toxicity data for that product can be used in support of this product.
3. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label for before your release the product for shipment. Please refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.


