



WHERE TO USE

To kill ants, black widow spiders, carpet beetles, centipedes, cigarette beetles, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, Indian meal moths, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles, scorpions, silverfish, sowbugs and spiders: spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including:

- dark corners of rooms and closets
- cracks and crevices in walls
- along baseboards and door and window frames
- behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets
- around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations.
- ant trails and around doors and windows.
- Wherever these pests enter home

To kill black carpet beetles, spray

Along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected of hiding.

To kill brown dog ticks and fleas:

Spot treat:

- Pet beds and resting quarters
- Nearby cracks and crevices
- Along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present.

Remove old pet bedding and replace with clean fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

Treat pets with a registered flea and tick control product before returning pet to treated areas.

For crack and crevice treatment of ants, black widow spiders, brown dog ticks, carpet beetles, cockroaches, crickets, fleas, scorpions, silverfish, sowbugs and spiders:


Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where these insects hide.

- **Flies and mosquitoes:** use only outdoors to control these pests. Spray: outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home.
- **Spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may be found.** Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat when needed.

Spray directly on insects when seen.

Do not spray on plants.

Do not treat pets with this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL


