The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Mecoprop-p (MCP-p) Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling

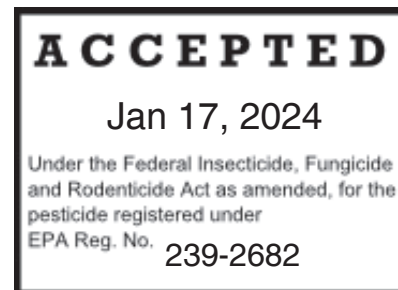

Quick Connect Sprayer. 1. Pull/Remove sprayer [from bottle]. Pull cord/hose ALL THE WAY OUT. 2. Insert [color] plug/connector into [color] spout/opening [on cap] [until it clicks]. 3. Flip up /Twist/Turn/Pull spout/knob/lid. [Open nozzle at end of sprayer]. 4. Adjust/Twist/Turn sprayer nozzle to a desired spray/spray pattern [spray pattern icon]. Option 3 – Pull 'N Spray

[Applicator (Device) (Applicator Name) Directions]

HOW TO USE:

Spray

1. Remove sprayer [from holster/holder/side carrier].
2. Unwrap [uncoil] hose and insert [color] hose connector into [color] spout/opening on [bottle] cap/knob/lid/opening [until it clicks].
3. [Flip up [color] spout until fully upright] / [Twist/Turn spout/knob/lid/cap to "ON"] / [Pull spout up].

3. DO NOT DISCONNECT HOSE CONNECTOR FROM SPOUT/CAP/KNOB/OPENING.
- [4. Place sprayer back into [on] holster [holder].]





	Remove the [applicator name] [applicator] by pulling the [color of plug] [red] plug from the [color of spout] [red] spout/opening on cap. [Illustration]
	[At the bottom of the side [clip] [carrier] [holder] press the middle tab up and slide the [clip] [carrier] [holder] upwards to remove it from the bottle.] [Illustration]

Spray

Important Use Information: Do not submerge in water. When storing sprayer for long periods, remove batteries.

To replace batteries: Open battery compartment at bottom of [applicator name] wand. Optional Trouble Shooting Section for Battery Powered Wand

[Troubleshooting Tips:

Problem: Sprayer does not spray (function).

Possible Cause: Batteries not installed properly.

Solution: See instructions for correct battery placement.

Problem: Sprayer makes a straining noise (Sprayer runs but nothing (no product) comes out).

Possible Cause: Nozzle is turned Off.

Solution: Turn nozzle to (desired) spray setting (position).

Possible Cause: Sprayer is not primed.

Solution: Press and hold button on sprayer for about X (10, 15, 20, 30) seconds to prime the sprayer.

Problem: Spray pattern is weak (or uneven) (product flow is uneven or dribbles out of nozzle).

Possible Cause: Weak batteries.

Solution: Install a fresh set of batteries.

Possible Cause: Nozzle not fully open.

Solution: Turn nozzle to (desired) spray setting (position).]

OR

1. Remove sprayer [from [side] holster/carrier/holder] [and] [Remove clear plastic film from the sprayer].
 [Remove plastic tab/strip near top of sprayer to activate batteries]
2. Unwrap/Uncoil tubing/hose
3. [Remove seal from cap]/[Unplug/Remove cap]
4. Securely snap/Insert the plug/[color] hose connector into hole in cap/[color] spout/opening on [bottle] cap. [Flip up [color] spout until fully upright]/[Twist/Turn spout/knob/cap to "ON"]/[Pull spout/cap up]
5. Twist/Turn/Rotate [sprayer] nozzle to desired spray pattern/ adjust spray from Close [Icon] to Spray [Icon] or Stream [Icon]
6. [When priming the sprayer, hold [sprayer] level to the ground. Sprayer/It may not prime if held at an angle. Once primed, it will spray in any direction
7. Press trigger to spray . Aim at center of weed and spray to lightly cover. [Do not point sprayer nozzle towards your face or eyes]
8. [Release trigger to stop spraying]
9. [[After use,]twist/turn/rotate sprayer nozzle to "off"/"X" for storage]
10. [Return sprayer to [side] holster/carrier/holder]

[Troubleshooting]

[If sprayer does not work with initial attempt, open the battery door. Use pencil or object to gently push the white button on the side of the sprayer. Assure battery tab is fully removed and assure batteries are properly seated]





To refill 1.25 Gallon EH-1398 Herbicide [Product Name]: Add entire contents [6.4 fl oz] of ORTHO Weed-B-Gon Lawn Weed Killer₃ [Product Name] [EPA Reg. No. 239-2665] to this empty 1.25 Gallon container. Slowly fill with 122 fl. oz. of clean tap water.

[1.33 gallon size]

To refill 1.33 Gallon EH-1398 Herbicide [Product Name]: Add entire contents [6.8 fl oz] of ORTHO Weed-B-Gon Lawn Weed Killer₃ [Product Name] [EPA Reg. No. 239-2665] to this empty 1.33 Gallon container. Slowly fill with 160 fl. oz. of clean tap water.
