On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided you agree in writing to:

- 1. Submit the following outstanding product chemistry data requirement: one year storage stability and corrosion characteristics study, within one year from the date of this letter.
- 2. After the word "CAUTION" add "Contains Petroleum Distillate".
- 3. The "First Aid" section must follow directly after the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals Statements". The "First Aid" section should be placed within a box. The "If Swallowed" section must be changed to "Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.". Also add "Note to Physician: May pose an aspiration pneumonia hazard. Contains petroleum distillate. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-XXX-XXXX for emergency medical treatment information."

- 4. The "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section must be changed to "Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing.". Move "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact people or pets. Only persons applying this product may be in the area during application" to the "Directions for Use" section. The "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section must be moved to the front of the label (after KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN CAUTION...) and must be placed in front of the "First Aid" section. The "Environmental Hazards" statements must follow after the "First Aid" section.
- 5. To the "Storage and Disposal" section change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" and change "Disposal" to "Pesticide Container Disposal". Place the "Storage and Disposal" section within a box.
- 6. Remove "one application kills and prevents all season" from the label, since in the label it says lasts for 4 months (4 months does not equal all season in some part of the United States).
- 7. Change "Covers up to 1000 square feet" to "Covers up to 500 square feet".

REPLANTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR MULCHED (LANDSCAPE) AREAS IMPORTANT:

Use the Replanting chart below for when to replant.

Plant	Weeks to Wait for planting
Trees & Shrubs	4 weeks
Annuals & Perennials	8 weeks

When replanting follow these steps:

- 1) Use garden gloves
- 2) Dig the planting hole
- 3) Set aside the removed soil
- 4) Put the plant in the hole and fill-in with a garden soil [such as Miracle-Gro Garden Soil].
- 5) Spread the removed soil in an area where no vegetation is desired.

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply to (unwanted) actively growing weeds and grasses. If weeds are taller than 6 inches, they should be cut down and removed before application. Apply when the air is calm to avoid drift.

HOW TO APPLY: (see below for specific use site directions.)
Apply with a tank sprayer. When treating around desirable
plants, shield the plants from drift with a sheet of cardboard or
plastic. If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse off
immediately with water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
