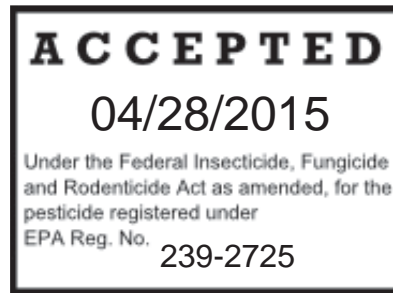

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Glyphosate, the primary active ingredient in NSR-001/product name/this product is absorbed by weeds through foliage and moves systemically to the roots, killing the weeds by stopping the function of an essential enzyme found in plants. Weeds die...roots and all – so they don't grow back.

The other active ingredients in NSR-001/product name/this product create a barrier in the soil that prevents growth of new weeds and grasses for up to four months.

## WHERE TO USE:
