The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

The alternate brand names "Ortho Home Defense Insect Killer for Lawns Granules", "Ortho Home Defense Lawn Insect Killer Granules", "Ortho Home Defense Lawn Insect Killer", and "Ortho Home Defense Insect Killer for Lawns" has been added to the product record.
