

5% SEVIN* DUST DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION: Make first application when insect or egg masses are first seen. Apply 25 to 30 lbs. of dust per acre. Dust thoroughly the lower as well as the upper leaf surfaces. Repeat application at 5 to 7 day intervals or as needed for control.

VEGETABLES

BEANS: To control the Mexican Bean Beetle, Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetle, Velvet Bean Caterpillar, Corn Earworm, Armyworms, Stink Bugs and Leafhoppers.

CABBAGE, COLLARDS: To control Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Harlequin Bug, Corn Earworm, Armyworms, Cabbage Caterpillars, Tarnished Plant Bugs, and Stink Bugs. Dust can be applied up to 3 days of harvest on cabbage; 14 days on collards.

CUCUMBERS, CANTALOUPE, PUMPKINS, MELONS, AND SQUASH: To control Cucumber Beetles, Melonworm, Pickleworm, Flea Beetles, Squash Bug, and Leafhoppers.

OKRA: To control Corn Earworm and Stink Bugs.

POTATOES: To control Blister Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle, and Leafhopper.

EGG PLANT, PEPPER, AND TOMATOES: To control Tomato Fruitworm, Fall Armyworm, Tomato Hornworm, European Corn Borer, Stink Bugs, Lace Bugs, and Tarnished Plant Bugs.

CATS AND DOGS

POULTRY


