DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO OPERATE - Remove cap. Hold bomb in upright position about 18 to 24 inches from objects being sprayed. Press nozzle directed at insects or objects to be sprayed.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS, HORNETS AND WASPS-

As a space spray to control these insects - Shut doors and windows, press valve and direct spray to all parts of rooms, especially the upper corners and other areas, allowing 5 to 10 seconds per average 1,000 cubic foot room. Also spray areas where pests may tend to congregate such as along baseboards, cracks in woodwork and other areas. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS, SILVERFISH, RESISTANT COCKROACHES, SCORPIONS, FLEAS AND

EARWIGS - Spray directly on insects wherever possible and in areas where insects may be found, such as under sinks, drainboards, stoves, cabinets, cracks and crevices, on baseboards,
